Respectfully sheweth
That

That your Petitioners were duly appointed Tutors Dative to the minor children before named under Letters of confirmation granted under the hand of the Master of the Supreme Court of this Colony bearing date respectively the thirtieth (31st) day of March 1880 and the twentyfirst (21st) day of April 1888, which said Letters are annexed hereto

That under and by virtue of a certain Deed of Transfer hereto annexed bearing date the 23rd day of August 1889 the said minor children are joint owners or proprietors together with Bert Knoetze and others in undefined shares, and in the proportions more clearly set forth in the said Deed of Transfer, of certain piece of perpetual Zuitrent land called "Swanepoelstraal" in the division of Stansenville formerly "Uitenhage" in the fieldcometey of Swartkops

in extent One thousand four hundred and eighty nine (1489) morgen four hundred and forty three (443) square rods

That it has been proposed by the said Gert Knochke that a division of the said landed property should be made and the respective shares therein of the several ~ proprietors properly defined

That it has become desirable and in the opinion of your petitioners it will be greatly to the benefit and advantage of the said Minor children ~ that the said land should be divided as they will then be in the free and undisturbed use and occupation of their defund portions and free to make many necessary ~ alterations and improvements thereon but which under the present circumstances they are loth to do.
